## WHY CHOOSE SELFHELP?

### Scholarships to Pursue MSW

6 full-time Masters of Social Work (MSW) students will be selected among accredited NYC area colleges to receive scholarships for Fall 2026.

### Up to \$10k Reimbursement

Students will receive up to a \$5k reimbursement per semester towards their tuition, up to \$10k per year value.

### 7 Internship Departments

Students will be placed into one of seven departments for their internship placement.

### One Year of Employment

Students will work at least one year following graduation as an employee with Selfhelp.

### Requirements of Applying

Only full-time MSW students. An application, essay, and interview are required. Preference is given to students with a concentration in gerontological social work. Bilingual in Russian, Chinese, or Korean is a plus.
